General Membership:

The YAC General Membership are a volunteer group whose members work on library projects, provide ideas and event feedback, and help plan YAC and library events under the leadership of the Leadership Council and library staff. General Membership is open to any local youth from 5th to 12th grade. The primary role of YAC members is to suggest and work on task force projects, volunteer to help with events, and create Youth Run Events. YAC members also help spread the word about library events and offer feedback about events they attend.

Responsibilities & Guidelines:

Attend all meetings and actively participate, and be a responsible library user and role model at YAC and other library events by acting in a way that reflects positively on the library. Arrive on time for all meetings and events and follow through with commitments made to YAC. Help promote youth participation at the library, be a library advocate, and promote reading and library use. Volunteer one hour every month and be respectful of the staff, each other, and the library.

The East Adams Library District Youth Advisory Council's mission is to engage youth as lifelong library users by promoting reading, volunteering, and participation in the library. YAC members help plan and execute library events and projects with library staff to make sure they reflect youth interests and the library community.
